

Natural Resources Scientist

TI is seeking an experienced Natural Resources Specialist whose role will be located at our Launceston Office, however the role will require the incumbent to travel throughout the state regularly.

This role reports to the General Manager Environment, Health and Safety.

The primary objective of this role is to support the implementation of Tasmanian Irrigation's environmental requirements by monitoring and reporting on its environmental compliance obligations for existing schemes, new schemes and supporting regulatory approval processes.

The key roles and responsibilities are:

- Implement and manage TI's surface water, groundwater and aquatic habitat monitoring program.
- Design water quality and habitat monitoring programs for each scheme when required.
- Contribute to the development and oversight of water quality monitoring programs for construction activities.
- Ensure reliable, validated and high-quality data for use in TI's compliance reporting.
- Complete reporting to meet State and Federal compliance obligations.
- Provide environmental support services to internal staff as required.
- Complete fauna and flora field surveys and impact assessments as required, including background research, data management, analysis and reporting.
- Manage the aquatic health of rivers and TI's storages; including algal blooms, aquatic weeds and pest fish.
- Complete permit applications such as permits to take flora and fauna.
- Other responsibilities as directed by the General Manager Environment, Health and Safety.

You will need to be tertiary (degree) qualified in Environmental Science, Ecology or a related discipline.

The successful candidate will understand and implement Workplace Health and Safety responsibilities.
