Don Irrigation Scheme


Scheme Performance

The 2024/25 irrigation season began with a slow start due to over 200 millimetres of rainfall, delaying early demand. However, this was followed by a prolonged dry period, leading to a substantial increase in water usage across the scheme.

As conditions dried out, irrigators made full use of their allocations, becoming more familiar with optimising their water usage. This season has marked a turning point for several landholders who are refining their on-farm setups and beginning to harness the full value of the scheme's supply.

Interest in winter water has also increased, with a reasonable volume either sold or subject to enquiries, indicating growing awareness of how to extend irrigation benefits throughout the year.

Operationally, the scheme performed well, with one key maintenance item identified: a scour valve replacement in Sheffield, which is scheduled for completion in the near term. This will further enhance reliability moving into the next season.







Water Delivery

The 2024-25 summer irrigation season ran for 181 days, opening on 1 October 2024 and closing on 31 March 2025. 100 per cent of the Scheme's water allocation was available and approximately 1,363 ML of water was delivered during the season. The volume delivered represents a 29 per cent utilisation rate of the Scheme's 4,750 ML total summer capacity.



Unsold Water

There are 1,210 ML of summer water entitlements remaining across the scheme as shown in the table below. Please note the current price is set to increase on 1 July 2025. Significant Winter water volumes are also available for purchase.
