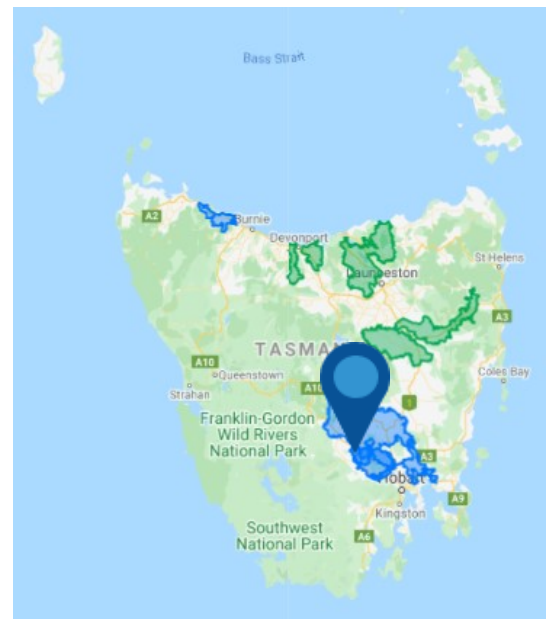
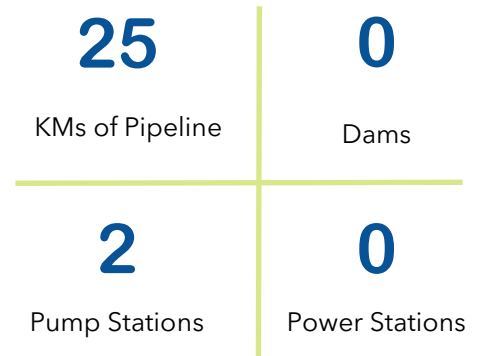


# Gretna Irrigation Scheme

## Tranche Three — phase two

The Gretna Irrigation Scheme will deliver high-surety irrigation water to landowners around Gretna in the Central Highlands and the Derwent Valley. Originally this area was to be serviced by the South East Integration Project. However, following the Expressions of Interest process, a high level of demand was recorded from the Gretna area. Preliminary costings indicate it is more cost effective to develop a stand alone scheme for this region. Under the current concept design, water will be sourced from the River Derwent at Meadowbank and pumped to irrigators via two pump stations.

Agricultural enterprises in the area include wool and lamb finishing, which is expected to expand to dairy, poppies, cereals, lucerne and fodder crops.
