

Sassafras Wesley Vale Augmentation

Tranche Three — Phase One

The Sassafras Wesley Vale Irrigation Scheme commenced operations in November 2012, delivering 5,660 ML to irrigators in the Sassafras, Harford, Thirlstane, Moriarty, Wesley Vale, Northdown, Pardoe and East Devonport areas in North West Tasmania.

In 2019, a survey was conducted in which 28 existing and 33 new irrigators expressed interest in an additional 5,745 ML.

The Augmentation project is being designed to expand the scheme and has the potential to deliver an additional 5,000 megalitres of high reliability irrigation water each year into one of the most productive agricultural regions in Tasmania.

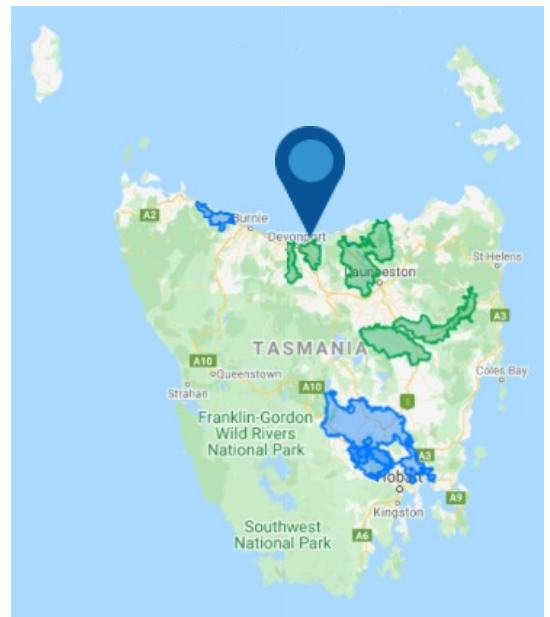
