We strongly encourage people to disclose the price of the transfers when submitting transfer forms. This enables TI to evaluate the trading market. Individual trade information is not disclosed.

Farm Water Access Plans:

Irrigators must comply with a Farm Water Access Plan (FWAP) when applying water from a scheme developed by Tasmanian Irrigation. An audit program is undertaken each year to ensure compliance with the FWAPs.

Tasmanian Irrigation is working with your Irrigator Representative Committee to develop permanent winter water entitlements for this scheme, for delivery outside of the existing summer period.

The existing committee has suggested that there would be benefits of combining the three South East irrigation district committees. We are formalising this process at the general meetings, with Stage 1 & Stage 2 representatives having been elected at their scheme meeting earlier in the year.
